Greetings!

We used to publish a price list but we soon realized that almost every job was different- either a large or small quantity, small or large sized pieces or different shapes and different textures such as antiqued or honed. We now quote pricing on a per job basis.

For budgeting or estimating purposes please consider the following:

Our basic starting price for sawn stone flooring is \$3.85 per sq.ft. For a 12" x 12" natural "cleft" (natural top and bottom surface) with sawed edges.

The 8" Pattern such as at the New Day Building Lobby @1724 Lampman Drive, Billings, MT. Bldg. #2, (8x8, 8x16, 16x16, 16,24) with an antiqued or tumbled finish is \$5.85 per sq. ft. The few 24" x 24" pieces included in that particular job were added at \$7.85 per sq. ft.

Basically as you get bigger than a 12" x 12", or you ask for an antiqued finish, the cost increases incrementally.
